DESCRIPTION

Instrument Panel

The instrument panel houses all of the heater / air conditioning controls as well as the radio, clock, rear window defroster switch, fog lamp switch, instrument panel dimmer switch and glove compartment.

Console, Floor


The floor console on this vehicle is divided into two sections; the front console and the rear console. The front section contains an ash receptacle, cigar lighter and gear shift selector. The rear section contains a storage tray, coin holder, parking brake lever, switch controls for power side view mirrors and a map/beverage holder.

REMOVAL AND INSTALLATION

Instrument Cluster Bezel

Removal

- Pull out storage compartment if equipped.
 Remove two upper and two lower screws, and heater/radio bezel.
- Remove trim covers located on both sides of steering column by pulling outward.
- Remove retaining screws and carefully pull instrument cluster bezel partially away from instrument panel.
- Disconnect electrical connectors from clock and switches in bezel.


Installation

- Connect electrical connectors to clock and switches.
- Position instrument cluster bezel and install retaining screws.
- Position trim covers on both sides of steering column and snap into place.
- Position heater/radio bezel and install securing screws.
- 5. Install storage compartment if equipped.

Removal


- 1. Disconnect negative battery cable.
- Remove LH and RH lower cowl trim panels. Refer to Section 01-05.
- Remove front and rear floor consoles as outlined.
- Remove heater / radio bezel, trim covers, instrument cluster bezel, and storage compartment as outlined.


- Remove instrument cluster. Refer to Section 13-01.
- 6. Remove steering column, Refer to Section 11-04.
- Loosen nut retaining hood release cable to lower instrument panel and position cable aside.
- 8. Remove radio. Refer to Section 15-01.
- Remove heater or A/C control panel. Refer to Section 12-01 or 12-03.
- Tag and remove all wiring harness retainers and connectors from instrument panel.
- Remove three screws, lockwashers and plain washers located near base of windshield.

- Remove two bolts and washers from each side of instrument panel. An access panel is provided for upper bolts.
- Remove two screws and lockwashers retaining instrument panel to center floor bracket.
- Remove two screws retaining instrument panel to steering column support.
- With an assistant, gently slide instrument panel outward. Disconnect ducts and wiring during removal.





- 16 Remove lamp, screws and upper glove compartment support bracket from instrument panel assembly.
- 17 Remove screws and radio support bracket.
- Remove defroster grilles from instrument panel pad.
- Remove two screws above instrument cluster, three screws above glove compartment, and two screws from underside of instrument panel. Remove instrument panel pad.




Installation

- Install passenger side register into instrument panel pad.
- 2. Install instrument panel pad with screws and tighten securely.
- 3. Install defroster grilles.
- 4. Install radio support bracket into instrument panel.




- With an assistant, position instrument panel on its support braces. Connect ducts and route wiring harness as needed.
- Install two screws retaining instrument panel to steering column support.
- Install two lockwashers and screws into center bracket. Tighten to 4-5 N·m (36-44 lb-in).
- Install four washers and bolts into sides of instrument panel. Tighten to 7-10 N·m (62-88 lb-in).
- Install access covers on both sides of instrument panel.
- Install three screws on instrument panel near windshield. Tighten securely.





- 12. Fasten wiring harness to instrument panel.
- Install heater or A/C control panel and connect cables. Refer to Section 12-02 or 12-03.
- 14. Install radio. Refer to Section 15-01.

- Position hood release cable and tighten retaining nut.
- 16. Install steering column. Refer to Section 11-04.



- Install storage compartment, instrument cluster bezel, trim covers, and heater/radio bezel as outlined.
- 19. Install front and rear consoles as outlined.
- Install left and right lower cowl trim panels. Refer to Section 01-05.
- 21. Connect negative battery cable.
- Check all instruments and controls for proper operation.
- Check for instrument panel rattles or squeaks. Service as required.



Glove Compartment

Removal and Installation

- Squeeze in sides of glove compartment. Allow it to open completely.
- 2. Remove screws retaining hinge to the instrument panel. Remove glove compartment.



- Install striker and screws. Check operation. Adjust if required.




